Course Background

National Youth Leadership Training is an intense, but fun, six-day outdoor leadership training experience for Troop youth leaders. The course will take place over two weekends. Its principle function is to help Scoutmasters improve the quality of their Troop by training their top boy leaders in the art of leadership, team building, decision making and conflict resolution. This course was developed nationally by the BSA and follows the material provided in the latest National Youth Leadership Training syllabus. NYLT is modeled after the 21st Century Wood Badge training for adults.

Registration Fees

Cost of the course will be **\$160** and is due with registration. This fee covers the cost of course materials, T-shirt, neckerchief, patch and all meals.

Registration fees are not refundable, but may be transferred to another Scout.

Requirements

To take part in the NYLT Course, each Scout must meet the following criteria:

1. Be at least 13 years old and a First Class Scout by the first day of the course.
2. Currently hold, or plan to hold, a leadership position in your Troop.
3. Obtain permission from your Scoutmaster to take the NYLT course.
4. Have completed Troop Leadership Training in the Troop or District.
5. Complete and send this Registration Form along with a check to the Central Minnesota Council Office by May 1, 2009.
6. Provide a Class I Health History form. (Turn in on the first day of the course)

Registrations are needed by the May 1, 2009 deadline to ensure enough materials are available for the participants.

Uniforms

Participants are expected to wear the full BSA uniform, which includes the official shirt with appropriately placed patches, belt and official pants, shorts or "Switchbacks". Participants will be provided a course T-shirt and a neckerchief. Participants will also receive a Red Pine Trail NYLT patch upon completion of the course.

What to Bring?

A personal equipment list will be sent to each Scout once registration is received at the Council Office. Cooking gear, patrol equipment and tents are provided.
