Who may attend?

This great event will be open to all registered Wolf Scouts from the Gateway and Scenic Districts. This is a fantastic way to celebrate your year as a Wolf Scout. A minimum of two adults per five Wolf Scouts are required, but all Wolf Scout parents/guardians are welcome.

In order to provide a quality program, a minimum of 100 Wolf Cubs must be registered by Friday, March 6th. The Gateway District Activities committee reserves the right to cancel district events not meeting minimum requirements.

What is Wolf Howl?

Wolf Howl is a day where each participant will experience many different and exciting events revolving around physical and mental fitness. There will be several events to test strength and ability. Such events may include hockey shoot-out, football throw, games and much more to make a memorable day for any Wolf Scout.

When is it?

Saturday, March 14th. Mark your calendar!

Check-In: 9:30 – 10 a.m. Check-In will not begin before 9:30 a.m.

Wolf Howl will conclude by 3:00 p.m.

Where is it?

What is the cost?

Fee is \$15.00 per Wolf Scout. **Pre-registration is mandatory** so adequate amounts of program materials and supplies can be ordered.

Parents/adults attend at no charge.

Fee covers program materials, building usage, Wolf Howl patch, and workshop style presentation by Wildlife Science Center personnel.

Registration fees are non-refundable but are transferable to another Wolf Scout.

What do you bring?

Your own lunch – lunch is not provided. Bring a swimsuit (no cut-offs) and towel. **Wear your Wolf uniform and tennis shoes.**

What about supervision?

Wolf Howl will be staffed by volunteer leaders from the Gateway District - CMC.

Adults attending should plan on being involved in the activities. Direct supervision of the boys is the responsibility of the parents and adults attending from each pack, by doing this it will ensure that everyone has good time.

What is the next step?

Fill out health form/permission slip for Scouts and Adult health information for adults attending. Register with your den leader as soon as possible by handing in forms and the paying fee. Make payment to your pack. Den leaders will turn in a registration sheet and fees to Central Minnesota Council – BSA, and bring health forms - permission slips to the event.

*** Make sure Scouts eat a good breakfast before arriving.**



Directions to Foley High School: 621 Penn Street

Foley is located at the crossroads of Hwy 25 and Hwy 23. The Foley High School is east of Hwy 25 on Hwy 23 on the north side behind the Sheriff's Department. Please use the High School entrance.

If you are coming north on Hwy #169, take County Road # 12 west from Hwy #169. County Road #12 is north of Princeton. This road turns into County Road 4 which takes you right to Hwy. 23 in Foley. Turn right on Hwy #23. The School is on the north side of Hwy #23.

Check-In will not begin before 9:30 a.m.

What to do upon arrival once Check – In has began?

Each Wolf Scout and adult partners are to check in at the registration table where you will be told what group you are in. Be sure to know your PACK NUMBER. If you have not handed in your health forms and paid your registration fees please do so when you check in. At the event, fees for Wolf Howl are to be made payable to CMC – BSA. One Den Leader or Key Adult from each Pack or Den will receive a packet with schedules, maps and evaluation forms for your pack or den. You will then go to your groups meeting place in the cafeteria, to leave your lunch and other belongings, receive handouts from your group leader.
