

Klondike Sled Information Guide:

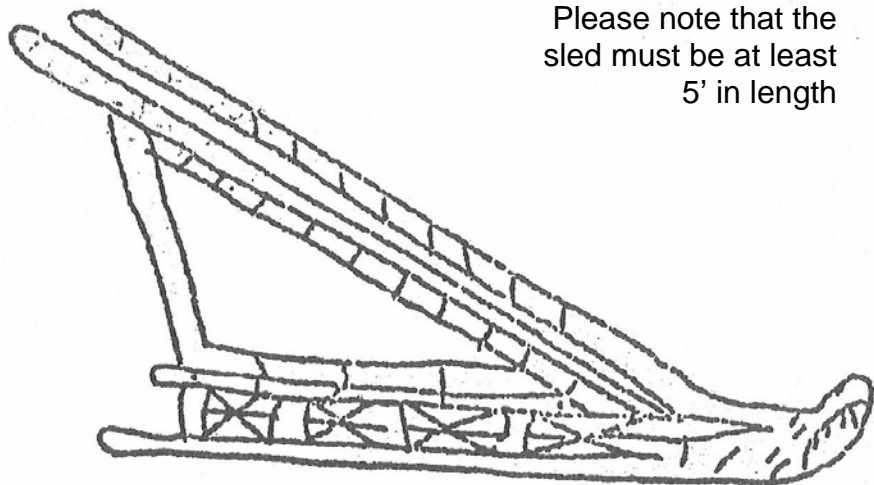
Suggested specifications of sled:

1. Length – five feet or more
2. Must have 2 runners with a width of approximately 2 ½ inches
3. Must not use more than 6 metal fasteners or bolts. Lashing will be required
4. Sled must be built by the boys who enter it, and can only be used for that year.

General Rules:

1. Each patrol has an opportunity with a team of 5 to 8 boys.
2. Sled must be constructed to be able to carry one Boy Scout.
3. Each team must complete the entire course which will be approximately 1 ½ miles long
4. During the course each team will encounter 10 stations at which they will demonstrate a specific Scout skill.

This is a rough diagram which may give you an idea as to what your sled should look like. It's specifications do not have to be followed exactly.



Please note that the sled must be at least 5' in length

Remember that each sled must carry the following items: first aid kit, patrol flag, matches for the fire station, scout book, pen, paper, a blanket and a 100' rope. If you have any questions about the regulations of the sled please contact Bob Pederson, 320-251-3930 ext.113
