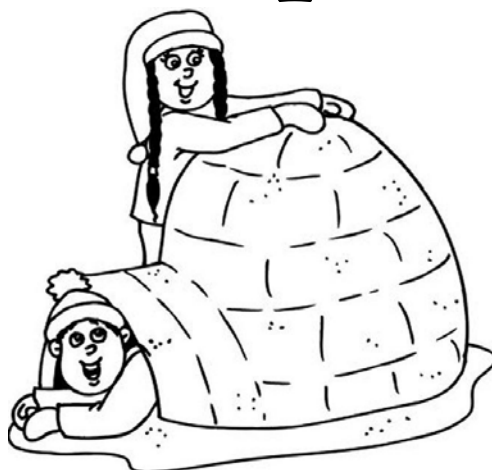


# 2010 Camp Nanuq
