**2010 Philmont Contingent Information – CENTENNIAL TRIP**

Dear Interested Philmonter:

One of the greatest experiences you'll ever have as a youth or an adult is to partake in the Philmont Backpacking Adventure. The Central Minnesota Council, BSA is forming a contingent (male only or coed for crews). 12 Scouts/Scouters from throughout the Central Minnesota Council area may become part of the contingent. Each year approximately 20,000 Scouts and leaders hike the 137,000 acres of Philmont property located in the foothills of the Rocky Mountains in New Mexico.

Our plans are to arrive at Philmont Saturday, June 19, 2010 at 10 am and depart Thursday, July 1, 2010 (this means we meet here the evening of Tuesday, July 10 and arrive back here Friday, July 2 (depending on travel stop options). **Cost will be \$725 per person.** You are encouraged to plan one training weekend to help the crew prepare for Philmont. There should be a parent/Scout information meeting in March 2010 to select treks and discuss training and equipment needs. The travel routes and side trips will be determined by each crew with guidance from me. Transportation to Philmont is each crew's responsibility. **At least one person per crew must have American Red Cross Wilderness First Aid training.**

The contingent will accept the first 12 youth or adults. Scouts or Crew members **must be** at least 14 years old by January 1, 2010, **or have completed the 8<sup>th</sup> grade by June 10, 2010**, hold a First Class rank or higher for a Boy Scout, and have Scoutmaster or Crew adviser approval.
