

Ripley Rendezvous 2010

Commemorating the last 100 years, by Preparing for the next 100 years



What is going on:

TRAILBLAZER program is for 1st and 2nd year Scouts – includes Super Troop activities; like Signaling, First Aid, Orienteering, and other mental and physical challenges. Active Military Equipment display and tour (not at the Museum) *What to Bring: Compass (1 per unit), Bandana Belt, Paper, Pencil, Scout Book, Water Bottle, Class A Uniform. Do not bring a neckerchief slide to the Program area on Saturday.*

ADVENTURE program is for 13 years old and up. Program consists of shotgun shooting, .22 rifles, .45 cal black powder rifles, field archery, and various displays and demonstrations. Participate in the Super Troop Challenges and designate your best shooters for this competition. (only 1 shooter per discipline will be scored)

X-TREME program is for male or female youth ages 14, completed 8th grade and older – *this group will be not be housed with their troops.* X-TREME is an advanced outdoor skills and teambuilding program. It will challenge you and your team mentally and physically. The X-Treme program will be housed in a separate building both nights and will spend the entire day Saturday down-range in the backwoods of Camp Ripley. The program is open to Boy Scouts or Ventures' (male and female) who are at least 14 years old or have completed 8th grade. This program is why you became a Scout!

When:

April 23-25, 2010. Check-in is between 5:30 and 7:30 p.m. Assigned housing will be mailed 1 week prior to the event. Please check in as a unit with your assigned Barracks Chief. Departure is at 10:30 a.m. on Sunday, **AFTER YOUR CAMP GOOD TURN. YOU MUST CHECK OUT WITH STAFF BEFORE LEAVING.**

Where:

CAMP RIPLEY – Follow signs off highway 371, north of Little Falls, exit west to Randall, hwy 115. Continue west to Camp Ripley's main gate.

Cost:

\$35 per youth and **\$35** per adult by 4 p.m. on Thursday March 25, 2010. **\$45 per person** after 03/25/10. Fees cover program materials, facility rental, entertainment, demonstrations and food. Fee is transferable to another Scout but not refundable.

What to Bring:

- * sleeping bag (or blankets) pillow, and personal hygiene items.
- * Clothing for any kind of weather (Be prepared)
- * Flash lights / Cameras / compasses / sun glasses / Scout books

Fill out the registration form and **INCLUDE THE REGISTRATION FEES!** We cannot hold your spots unless paid in full. Anyone not pre-registered may participate, but we cannot guarantee to match your program needs.

Housing:

All registered Scouts, Adults, and Staff will be housed in the Area 10 buildings. Assigned quarters will be provided prior to the event date.

2010 RIPLEY CMC BSA RENDEZVOUS X-TREME PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION OF PROGRAM:

The X-treme Program is a high-adventure activity for Boy Scouts, non-Scouts that apply for the program, and Venture Scout units. It is designed as a co-ed program for youth over 14 years of age that meet minimum physical fitness requirements.

The X-treme Program is part of the Ripley Rendezvous / CMC BSA. This high-adventure program takes place in the field / range area outside the cantonment area of Camp Ripley, and consists of several skill stations and a land navigation exercise.

2010 Ripley Rendezvous

REGISTRATION – Youth and staff participants must register with the CMC BSA Scout Office.

***DATES** – Youth are asked to be at Camp Ripley no later than 8:00 PM Friday, April 23. No participants will be accepted into the program after 11:00 PM Friday. Later arrivals may be at a disadvantage because of the briefing program conducted Friday night from 9:00-10:30 PM .*

***GEAR & EQUIPMENT** – Youth will be asked to bring a variety of specific clothing, which will be outlined after they have registered.*

***PHYSICAL FITNESS / CONDITIONS** - The skill stations and the land navigation require stamina and generally good physical fitness. The program runs for the entire day on Saturday, and can fatigue the youth participants. All personnel in the program will be subject to the natural elements without shelter for the entire day.*

***CREWS** – The program is designed for 30 crews of 10 youth in each crew, however, crews will be organized Friday evening as the youth arrive and register with the program. Most crews are contingency units comprised of individuals from various troops and Venture units from various BSA Councils combined into a crew unit. We encourage any older youth in a Scout troop or Venture unit to consider coming and joining into a crew.*
