

# Klondike Derby 2011

- When: February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2011  
8:30am – 4:00pm  
Check-in is Saturday morning at the Admin Building from 8:30 – 9:20 a.m.
- Where: Parker Scout Reservation, Merrifield, MN
- Who: All Troops, Crews, and 2<sup>nd</sup> year Webelos Dens only
- Cost: \$10 per Scout, First 2 adults free (\$5 per leader after), **pre-registration is required, no exceptions.**  
Fee includes: Saturday lunch, camp fees, patches.
- What: Test your Scouting Skills in a competition that includes Orienteering, winter first aid, Ice Rescue, Fire building and the Great Klondike Sled Race!

## Overall Concept:

- It is a Boy Scout Winter Skills event, held every winter in the snow.
- The Klondike Derby is a team type competition, where Boy Scout Patrols compete against the clock and each other.
- Boys are divided into patrols, and each patrol uses a boy-built Dog sled that uses Scout power to pull it instead of dogs.
- The Scouts pull the sleds, loaded with their personal and patrol equipment, journey through the woods and fields to 5 training stations, where they are tested on different winter skills.

## Sled Requirements

### **Complete requirements and building instructions on page 3.**

Sleds must be built *this Scouting year* using lashing.

The sled needs to be built out of native wood; the only fasteners allowed are for the runners.

One Scout must ride the sled.

Each sled must carry the following items:

First Aid Kit, Patrol Flag, Matches for the Fire Station, Scout Book, Pen, Paper, Blanket, 100' Rope, Fire Box, Compass, and Triangle Bandage

- Scouts will have to use a map and compass to navigate themselves and their sleds to their destinations, (each activity station).
- When they arrive at these stations they are timed and tested on their Scouting knowledge, their team work and their problem solving skills.
