- Who may attend?** This great event will be open to all registered Boy Scouts and Ventures from the Gateway District. 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Webelos are welcome to attend this event as well, but must be attached with a Troop. This is a fantastic way for your troop to incorporate those newly transitioned Webelos Scouts into your unit with a great program and guaranteed weather conditions, Indoor Camping!! A minimum of two adults is required for each troop and one adult per ten Scouts. We also need additional adults to help support the program activities.
- In order to provide a quality program and insure that the event is not cancelled, a minimum of 75 Boy Scouts must be registered by Thursday, February 2<sup>nd</sup>.
