



CENTRAL MINNESOTA COUNCIL DISTRICT AWARD NOMINATION

Take time to say thank you to the key people who have made a positive impact in your Scouting Program. Nomination for this award is confidential. Please do not advise the nominee in any way of your nomination.

Boy Scouter, Cub Scouter, and Scouter Awards are district awards that recognize the outstanding service to youth by any key individuals or groups. The nominee(s) may have accomplished this in many ways. The outcome of their work always has the same result "**the unit or district has been improved by their dedication to Scouting**". Take a moment to think about this, fill out the form and send it in. Often, they are not noticed by others or are "behind the scenes".

The District Award of Merit is a council award presented by districts in the same manner that the Silver Beaver is a national award presented by councils. It is available to Scouters who provide outstanding service at the district level. The award is made available annually on the basis of 1 award for each 25 units or fraction thereof. The District or Exploring division may decide to present some or all of the awards to which it is entitled each year. The recipient can only receive this award once.

Nomination Qualifications –

For a District Scouter Award the nominee must:

1. Be a currently registered Scouter.
2. Have rendered outstanding service to youth. Long tenure is not, by itself, enough to qualify. It must be outstanding, dedicated service.
3. The nomination must be supported by the unit committee.

For the District Award of Merit the nominee must:

1. Be a currently registered Scouter.
2. Have contributed some service to youth outside of Scouting.
3. Have rendered noteworthy service to youth. The nature and value of this service may consist of a single plan or decisions that contributed vitally to the lives of large numbers of youth or it may have been given to a small group over an extended period of time.

Consideration will also be given to:

1. The nominee's attitude toward and cooperation with the district, division, and/or council.
2. The nominee's position and the corresponding opportunity to render outstanding service beyond the expectation of duty.

Nominations must be in writing.
