QUALITY PROGRAM & COMMUNITY SERVICE

- Television and radio personality, Ron Schara was the guest speaker at our 5th Annual Saint Cloud Area Friends of Scouting Leadership Breakfast.
- An estimated 30,000 hours of community service were provided by our Scouts during 2009.
- Good Turn for America projects collected a record 103,000 pounds of food.
- 320 Scouts participated in our inaugural council-wide Merit Badge Clinic weekend.
- 172 Scouts signed up to go to the 2010 National Scout Jamboree at Fort A.P. Hill in Virginia.
- Adopted a 100% Top Leader Training Requirement to be implemented in 2010.
- 63% of our program units achieved Centennial Quality Program recognition.
- 248 Scoutreach participants, funded by United Way and ING Direct.

QUALITY CAMPING

- The Jim & Marion Miller Castle, Medieval Times Program Facility was dedicated in July.
- Miller Castle and the Medieval Times Program were featured on ABC Channel 5 EYEWITNESS NEWS "On the Road" with Jason Davis.
- 560 Scouts & 460 adults attended Cub/Webelos Scout Resident Camp (12% increase over 2008).
- 62% of our Boy Scouts participated in a week-long summer camp experience.
- 391 Cub Scouts participated in Day Camps.
- Camp Nanuq (our new Cub Scout winter camp) sold out with 140 participants.
- 151 Boy Scouts participated in Alpha Lupus, Kota High Adventure, and Klondike winter camp events.
- Re-established Counselor-In-Training (CIT) program that provides leadership opportunities, service hours for advancement, and peer mentoring.
