For those of you who were a part of ArrowCorps⁵, you know how big of an impact you had on the national forests. You know how amazing the experience was. You know the lifelong friendships and lessons that were a result of this great undertaking. Because of all this, the Order of the Arrow leadership from sections C-1A and C-1B began planning for a similar event right here in Area 1. ArrowPower²⁰¹¹ is a project that has been in the planning stages for about two years and will be conducted at the Superior National Forest with base headquarters in Grand Marais, MN. It will take place from June 21-26, 2011 and primary projects include construction of campsites and portage trails on the Vegetable Chain of Lakes, trail maintenance on the Superior Hiking Trail, and constructing two mountain biking trails within the forest.

ArrowPower²⁰¹¹ is going to be very similar to ArrowCorps⁵ in that we are preparing for 500 participants, which means getting registered early is critical. The first step in participating in this great event is to contact your lodge leadership immediately. Cost for the event will be \$195 per person. Therefore, this experience is something that will be more reasonable in price than ArrowCorps⁵ and it will also potentially be closer to home for many Arrowmen. This means more convenient travel as well as having an impact on a forest that many scouts from our area use throughout the year.
