WHEN?

APRIL 27-29, 2012. Check-in is between 6:00 and 8:30 p.m. Housing assignments (barracks, bays) will be emailed 1 week prior to the event to the unit contact. Please check in as a unit with your assigned Barracks Chief.

Departure is at 10:30 a.m. on Sunday, **AFTER YOUR CAMP GOOD TURN. YOU MUST CHECK OUT WITH STAFF BEFORE LEAVING.**

WHERE?

CAMP RIPLEY – From the east, follow signs off highway 371, north of Little Falls, exit Highway 115 West to Randall. From the west, from Highway 10, exit onto Highway 115 East at Randall. Continue to Camp Ripley's main gate.

COST?

\$35 PER YOUTH AND \$35 PER ADULT by 4 p.m. on Monday, April 16, 2012. Fees cover program materials, facility rental, entertainment, demonstrations and food.

Fee is transferable to another Scout but not refundable.

WHAT TO BRING?

- Sleeping bag (or blankets) pillow, personal hygiene items. Bunk beds and showers are provided.
- Clothing for any kind of weather (Be prepared) Extra shoes or boots for the weather.
- Flash lights / cameras /compasses /sunglasses / Scout books
- **SMALL** bills for the Trading Post and Canteen
