To assist you- there are many resources at your disposal. Your unit leaders or your district executive, as well as many on line resources. Talk to your scoutmaster or crew leader. Use the council website for its resources or call us. Everyone wants you to succeed. Every adult leader will help you to the best of their ability.

Here are a couple of things to keep in mind as you work through the process:

- Your District Eagle board must approve your Eagle Service project BEFORE you begin to execute your project. Project workbooks need to be submitted to the council office no later than the Friday prior to the last Monday of the month prior to the Eagle board meeting for approval.
- The Eagle application, final service project report and sealed reference letters must be submitted to the council office no later than the Friday before the last Monday of the month. (All applications are delivered to the board on the last Monday of the month. Your completed packet needs to be turned in by close of business on the Friday before the last Monday to be checked for required dates and information.)
- You will get a letter from us indicating the time of your review. The board is meeting on the second Tuesday of the month at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, which is by North Jr. High or at 1420 29th Ave N in St. Cloud.
- You will be reviewed by a board of three to six people.
