Wood Badge is an advanced leadership course open only to Scouting volunteers and professionals.

The purpose of Wood Badge is to develop skilled leaders who can strengthen Scouting units in achieving the mission of the Boy Scouts of America.

Topics covered include managing conflict, team development, leading change, and project planning

Eligibility

- All Registered adults involved in Cub Scouts, Scouts BSA, Venturing, Sea Scouts, Exploring, district, or council
- ▶ 18 years of age or older
- Completed basic training for position (most of which can be taken online at my.scouting.org)
- Capable of functioning safely in an outdoor environment
- Completion of Annual Health & Medical Record (Part A, B, and C)

You will learn and experience things that will stay with you the rest of your life.
